





Chart 1: Composite Passengers Movement Index, Percentage Change



- The Composite Passengers Movement Index (consisting of regional, international, and domestic arrivals and departures of passengers at airports) declined monthly by 4.5 percent in June 2023, relative to a decline of 5.0 percent observed a month earlier. Conversely, the index increased by 27.3 percent year-on-year (Chart 1).
- In absolute terms, a total of 79 187 passengers movement were recorded at airport terminals across the country during June 2023, compared to 82 895 passengers movement and 62 182 passengers movement that were observed in the preceding month and in the corresponding month of 2022, respectively.
- Hosea Kutako International Airport continue to be the main contributor to passengers' movement accounting for the largest share of 78.0 percent followed by Eros and Walvis Bay airports in second and third places with shares of 8.4 percent and 8.0 percent, respectively.


Chart 2: Arrivals Index for Eros Airport, Percentage Change¹



- The Arrivals Index for Eros Airport in June 2023 declined by 6.3 percent month on-month, in contrast to a growth of 5.4 percent observed in the previous month. Similarly, the index declined by 3.8 percent year-on-year (Chart 2).
- The number of passengers that arrived in June 2023 via Eros Airport terminals declined to 3 207 passengers from 3 423 passengers and 3 334 passengers registered a month earlier and in the corresponding period of 2022, respectively.



Chart 3: Departures Index for Eros Airport, Percentage Change



- The Index of **Departures for Eros Airport** in June 2023 registered an increase of 1.0 percent monthly unchanged from the previous month. Moreover, the index increased by 1.8 percent over the year (Chart 3).
- The number of passengers that departed through Eros Airport terminals in June 2023 stood at 3 422 passengers, as opposed to 3 389 passengers and 3 362 passengers registered in the preceding month and in the corresponding month of 2022, respectively.


Chart 4: Arrivals Index for Walvis Bay Airport, Percentage Change²



- The Arrivals Index for Walvis Bay Airport declined by 6.1 percent on a monthly basis in June 2023, as opposed to a marginal increase of 0.1 percent that was recorded in the preceding month. Annually, the index increased by 33.3 percent (Chart 4).
- In absolute terms, the number of passengers that arrived via Walvis Bay airport stood at 3 206 passengers compared 3 414 passengers and 2 406 passengers recorded a month earlier and in the corresponding month of 2022, respectively.



Chart 5: Departures Index for Walvis Bay Airport, Percentage Change³




- The **Departures Index for Walvis Bay Airport** in June 2023 registered a decline of 10.6 percent on a monthly basis, relative to a marginal reduction of 0.9 percent posted in May 2023. On the other hand, the index posted an increase of 30.8 percent year-on-year (Chart 5).
- In absolute terms, the number of passengers that departed via Walvis Bay airport declined to 3 125 passengers in June 2023 from 3 496 passengers recorded in the preceding month while 2 389 passengers were registered in the corresponding period of 2022.

Chart 6: Arrivals Index for Hosea Kutako Airport, Percentage Change



- The Arrivals Index for Hosea Kutako Airport registered a decline of 1.8 percent month-on-month in June 2023 relative to a deterioration of 9.0 percent posted in the preceding month. Conversely, the index registered an increase of 34.0 percent year-on-year (Chart 6).
- For June 2023, the number of passengers that arrived via Hosea Kutako Airport terminals declined to 31 272 passengers, from 31 834 passengers noted a month earlier, while 23 338 passengers were recorded in the corresponding month of 2022.

- The **Departures Index for Hosea Kutako Airport** in June 2023 on a monthly basis registered a decline of 7.4 percent, compared to relative reduction of 3.6 percent posted in the preceding month. Conversely, the index increased by 31.6 percent over the year (Chart 7).
- In absolute terms, the number of passengers that departed through Hosea Kutako airport terminals declined to 30 470 passengers in June 2023, from 32 910 passengers recorded in May 2023 while 23 160 passengers were recorded in the corresponding month of 2022.

Methodology

Background: The information in this report looks at both citizen and non-citizen travelers' arrivals and departures.

Data sources: Namibia Airports Company

Base year: The volumes have been referenced to 2015 data as of November 2019

Conversion: 1 basis point = 0.01 percent
