





PASSENGERS ARRIVALS & DEPARTURES JULY 2023

Chart 1: Composite Passengers Movement Index, Percentage Change



- The Composite Passengers Movement Index (consisting of regional, international, and domestic arrivals and departures of passengers at airports) recorded an increase of 22.2 percent in July 2023, in contrast to a decline of 4.5 percent posted in the preceding month. Additionally, the index increased by 20.7 percent year-on-year (Chart 1).
- In absolute terms, a total of 96 802 passengers movement was recorded at airport terminals across the country during July 2023, as opposed to 79 187 passengers movement and 80 213 passengers movement that was registered in the preceding month and in the corresponding month of 2022, respectively.
- Hosea Kutako International Airport continue to be the main contributor to passengers movement accounting for the largest share of 80.3 percent followed by Eros and Walvis Bay airports into second and third places with shares of 7.9 percent and 6.1 percent, respectively.

Chart 2: Arrivals Index for Hosea Kutako Airport, Percentage Change




- The Arrivals Index for Hosea Kutako Airport rebounded on a monthly basis registering an increase of 35.2 percent in July 2023 in contrast to a decline of 1.8 percent recorded in the previous month. Similarly, the index registered an increase of 21.0 percent year-on-year (Chart 2).
- For July 2023, the number of passengers that arrived via Hosea Kutako Airport terminals increased to 42 275 passengers, from 31 272 passengers and 34 943 passengers recorded a month earlier and in the corresponding month of 2022, respectively.





- The **Departures Index for Hosea Kutako Airport** in July 2023 on a monthly basis registered an increase of 16.4 percent, upward from a reduction of 7.4 percent posted in the preceding month. Moreover, the index increased by 27.2 percent over the year (Chart 3).
- In absolute terms, the number of passengers that departed through Hosea Kutako airport terminals increased to 35 477 passengers in July 2023, from 30 470 passengers and 27 900 passengers recorded in June 2023 and in the corresponding month of 2022, respectively.

Chart 4: Arrivals Index for Eros Airport, Percentage Change²




- The Arrivals Index for Eros Airport in July 2023 increased by 15.6 percent month-on-month, in contrast to a decline of 6.3 percent registered in the previous month. Similarly, the index increased by 1.8 percent year-on- year (Chart 4).
- The number of passengers that arrived in July 2023 via Eros Airport terminals increased to 3 706 passengers from 3 207 passengers and 3 642 passengers registered a month earlier and in the corresponding period of 2022, respectively.



Chart 5: Departures Index for Eros Airport, Percentage Change



- The Index of **Departures for Eros Airport** in July 2023 registered an increase of 13.8 percent compared to an increase of 1.0 percent that was recorded a month earlier. Additionally, the index grew by 7.0 percent over the year (Chart 5).
- The number of passengers that departed through Eros Airport terminals in July 2023 stood at 3 893 passengers, as opposed to 3 422 passengers and 3 637 passengers registered in the preceding month and in the corresponding month of 2022, respectively.

Chart 6: Arrivals Index for Walvis Bay Airport, Percentage Change³



- The Arrivals Index for Walvis Bay Airport on a monthly basis declined by 13.5 percent in July 2023, compared to a reduction of 6.1 percent that was registered in the previous month. Annually, the index increased by 5.7 percent (Chart 6).
- In absolute terms, the number of passengers that arrived via Walvis Bay airport declined to 2 773 passengers from 3 206 passengers noted a month earlier, while 2 623 passengers were recorded in the corresponding month of 2022.




Chart 7: Departures Index for Walvis Bay Airport, Percentage Change⁴

- The **Departures Index for Walvis Bay Airport** in July 2023 registered a marginal increase of 0.2 percent on a monthly basis, in contrast to a decline of 10.6 percent noted in June 2023. Moreover, the index posted an increase of 9.9 percent year-on-year (Chart 7).
- In absolute terms, the number of passengers that departed via Walvis Bay airport increased to 3 132 passengers in July 2023 from 3 125 passengers and 2 849 passengers recorded in the preceding month and in the corresponding period of 2022, respectively.

Methodology

Background: The information in this report looks at both citizen and non-citizen travelers' arrivals and departures.

Data sources: Namibia Airports Company

Base year: The volumes have been referenced to 2015 data as of November 2019

Conversion: 1 basis point = 0.01 percent
